  - Difficult to find a date at this point in the year with spring sports beginning, so we will skip this year. Would like to plan it next year for the Tuesday after HS state tournament.
- 3rd-8th grade banquet during week of April 4?
  - Confirm with Ericka
- 4th of July
  - Pig Roast Who will work with Lovick Family Farms and Lodi butcher? Discussion was had about the idea of discontinuing the pig roast. A difficult consideration, as it is a long-standing club tradition. Overall it seems that the cost of it (in terms of considerable time and effort on a holiday weekend) outweighs the benefits (minimal income and no known impact on registration numbers). Consideration to be made about alternative ideas that would be pig-roast related, such as a pop-up fundraiser (similar to a brat bust), or club parties featuring the pig roast. At the conclusion of this meeting, there was agreement that discontinuing the pig roast seemed logical.
  - Chelsea emailed those not present with a summary on this discussion, and asking for any input, which prompted a special meeting on April 13 to continue this discussion. Korey, Jessica, Tyler, Ericka, Chelsea and Robin were present. At this meeting, after further discussion and reflection, an alternate plan was determined. Rework the pig-roast so that it is one day only. Maintain the tradition while making it a more reasonable effort for the board/volunteers. This conversation will continue at the next board meeting.

    incorporate water guns and substitute freezer pops instead of candy. We need to share it
    with families now so that they can plan ahead to walk with the Gold Medal parade entry.

- 12. Reimbursement parameters did not discuss
  - Further communication of policy
  - Current language on website:

In an effort to keep our club registration fees low, we have elected against tournament reimbursement(s) for the 2021-22 season. We will continue to provide a code for the Gold Medal Wrestling tournament and offer an opportunity to wrestle at the Dunkin Duals (formerly Big Gain Duals). We will make considerations as a board for the following tournament reimbursements for individual wrestlers this year and in the future:

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-If a wrestler is unable to complete in regular season tournaments (those tournaments listed in Team Snap) due to financial constraints

-If a wrestler qualifies for State while registered as a Gold Medal wrestler\* we will reimburse the qualifier tournament registration fee and the state tournament registration fee

-If a wrestler is a State place winner while registered as a Gold Medal wrestler\* we will make additional considerations for competitive/national tournaments. These reimbursements are limited to tournament fee and hotel reimbursement for the wrestler. There will be a maximum of \$250 per calendar year/per wrestler allowed.

All requests should be made in advance of tournaments (other than the qualifier and state tournaments) and submitted to deforestwrestling@gmail.com for board review and approval. Any requests made that fall outside of these parameters will be reviewed by the board to determine if an exception is warranted.

\*Registration as a Gold Medal wrestler is defined as registering at the beginning of the season to be a wrestler of the club AND on the day of the tournament, Gold Medal Wrestling is listed as your club\*
